Community Speech Services, Inc. is a private practice whose services are focused on increasing or improving their clients' communication skills.

Communication difficulties affect millions of children and adults. (Communication disorders constitute the nation's number one handicapping disability). The degree of how each individual is affected is dependent on communication used in their daily activities. For instance, a child with only a slight lisp may be reluctant to read aloud in class. Or an adult with an articulation disorder may be misunderstood at work. Many clients who are diagnosed "non-verbal" have limited education/vocational opportunities. A child with autism may need practice with social skills. Thus, Community Speech Services, Inc. thoroughly evaluates each individual and works with them and/or their family to establish appropriate goals.

Community Speech Services, Inc. offers a flexible and varied schedule of times for our services. Any time of day and some early evening hours are available.

Evaluation	\$250.00
Therapy	\$40.00 (30 minute session)

We accept Medicaid and BCMH claims. We work with insurance companies, foundations and scholarship organizations to help cover the cost of speech/language services.

SPEECH THERAPY ATTENDANCE POLICY

1. Failure to attend: when a client does not attend a scheduled appointment and does not phone to cancel prior to the appointment, attendance is recorded as "failed".

a. A client who fails to attend three appointments within a 90 day period may be discharged from therapy. The client will be notified after each failure.

2. An attendance rate of 65% or below may result in:

b. Dismissal from therapy. (Prior to dismissal, the client will receive a letter allowing 30 days to improve attendance. Following the 30 day period, if attendance again falls below 65% over a 60 day period, the client may be dismissed from therapy).

****It should be noted that every attempt will be made to accommodate the clients schedule to ensure continuation of services.****

3. If a client is unable to attend therapy for a period of 30 to 60 days, he may request a temporary dismissal from therapy. Once able to attend regularly, the client can notify the speech department and can be scheduled at the next available opening.

4. If a client chooses to withdraw from therapy against professional recommendations to continue therapy, the client will be eligible for services 60 days after the dismissal date (at the client's request).

5. If a client is dismissed due to poor attendance, the client will again be eligible for services 90 days after the dismissal date (at the client's request).
